Irma: What are you doing, Misaki?

Misaki: Hello, Irma. I'm reading a newspaper. The title is "A"."

Irma: Sounds interesting.

Misaki: It says many people in Asia want to work in Japan. Why did you decide to work in Japan?

Irma: I worked as an online English teacher when I was in the United States, and when I taught a Japanese student, I got interested in Japanese culture. I think Japan is the safest and the most comfortable country for foreigners to live in.

Misaki: I'm happy to hear that. Actually, this article says that 23.9% of people have chosen to work in Japan because they are interested in Japanese culture.

Irma: That's more than the number of people who are interested in Japanese technology or companies.

Misaki: Right. On the other hand, there aren't so many people who come to Japan to make money. Only 7.4% answered so.

Irma: So, many people are attracted by Japanese culture like me.

Misaki: Yes, but non-Japanese workers have some problems when they work in Japan.

Irma: Some of my non-Japanese friends say that Japanese is so difficult that they can't communicate with other Japanese workers.

Misaki: But I know that some city offices give foreign workers some support. The Ibaraki International Association has a Foreign Consultation Center. They say workers from other countries can use the (B) <u>foreign consultation service</u> for free. Their service is given in many languages in addition to English and Japanese.

For example, workers can get support on Monday afternoons and Wednesdays in Chinese. Also, workers who speak Portuguese can get the service on Monday morning and Thursday. There are also other languages, such as Korean, Spanish and so on.

Irma: That's really useful. But there is another problem. Many of them are \*irregular workers, so their \*salaries are too low.


Misaki: Right. I think that giving non-Japanese workers a good working environment is important.

Irma: Do you know about the new \*law? It's called "equal pay for equal work." It started last April and focuses on equal pay for equal work between \*regular workers and irregular workers. Even when the amount of work is the same, regular workers get ( C ) money than irregular workers do. This is a big problem. I hope this law will help change this situation.

Misaki: I think this law is good for both Japanese and non-Japanese workers. I hope everyone can work happily in Japan.
